## School Uniform September 2016

As you know there are to be some minor changes to our school uniform from September 2016  
The uniform will be as follows:

Grey Trousers, skirt, pinafore dress (Not black or charcoal grey)

White shirt or white blouse (Not polo shirts)

Red knitted cardigan or jumper (No sweatshirts or fleeces)

School tie (Available from Uniform Centre Morley)

White socks or grey tights for girls. Grey socks may be worn with trousers  
(No red or black tights)

Grey socks for boys

Summer uniform remains the same—red & white checked dresses

Black school shoes (not trainer style shoes)

**PE Kit** — Red round neck t-shirt and black shorts

Plain black track suit

Plain trainers—no bright colours. (Some classes may require plain black pumps but individual teachers will advise at the start of the year)
