Just a reminder of the uniform and that from September 2017 the sweatshirt is no longer part of Hill Top Uniform.

Grey Trousers, skirt, pinafore dress (Not black or charcoal grey)

White shirt or white blouse (Not polo shirts)

Red knitted cardigan, or jumper

School tie (Now available from Uniform Centre Morley)

White socks or grey tights for girls. Grey socks may be worn with

Trousers (No red or black tights)

Grey socks for boys

Summer uniform remains the same—red & white checked dresses. These can be worn after Easter if the weather is warm enough.

Black school shoes (not trainer style shoes)

PE Kit —Red round neck t-shirt and black shorts

Plain black track suit

Plain trainers—no bright colours. (Some classes may require plain black pumps but individual teachers will advise at the start of the year)
