Dear Parent/Carer,

We would like to inform you that in line with Statutory Guidance and the Schools Admission Code (2021) Blackgates Primary Academy is consulting on their Admissions Policy for reception pupils who will start at Blackgates Primary Academy in September 2023. In September 2023/24, Leodis Academies Trust intends to change Pupil Admissions Number (PAN) at Blackgates Primary Academy from 60 to 30.

The consultation will take place for six weeks between **Monday 6 December 2021 and Monday 17 January 2022.**

This consultation does not apply to anyone making an application to start Reception in September 2022, who will apply using the Admissions Policy for September 2022 - August 2023.
