I am writing to advise you that <u>in all classes across school, including Nursery</u> members of our school community have tested positive for COVID-19.

- A high temperature children feel hot to touch on their chest or back and/or
- A new continuous cough coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours and/or
- A loss or change to their sense of taste or smell

If your child develops one of these symptoms, please keep them at home and book a PCR test (online at: <a href="https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test">https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test</a> or by phoning 119 between 7am and 11pm) and stay at home until you receive a result.
